

## THE STATUTE OF THE INTERNATIONAL INSTITUTE OF THE JUCHE IDEA

Article 1 This organization shall be called the International Institute of the Juche Idea (IIJI).

Article 2 The IIJI is an international organization of academic research and dissemination of the Juche idea.

Article 3 The IIJI has its mission to study and disseminate the Juche idea.

Item 2 The IIJI shall collect information of, assist and encourage academic activities for the study, dissemination and application of the Juche idea conducted by regional institutes and national Juche idea study organizations.

Article 4 According to its character and duty, the IIJI shall conduct the following activities:

- (1) to disseminate the classical works of Kim Il Sung, Kim Jong Il and Kim Jong Un;
- (2) to arrange seminars and lecture meetings on the Juche idea;
- (3) to publish academic magazine the “Study of the Juche Idea” once a year, “Newsletter” of the Secretariat of the IIJI every three months and other necessary publications;
- (4) to give academic cooperation and exchange experiences gained in the activities to study, disseminate and apply the Juche idea conducted in different countries over the world;
- (5) to open and manage internet homepage on the Juche idea.

Article 5 The IIJI shall keep contact with the organizations and individuals in different countries who are interested in the Juche idea.

Item 2 The IIJI may organize its member organizations in different countries and on continents.

Article 6 The leadership body of the IIJI is the Board of Directors.

Item 2 The Board of Directors shall consist of director general, deputy directors-general, secretary general and directors.

- (1) Director general shall be 1 person;
- (2) Deputy directors-general shall be 2 persons and less;

- (3) Secretary general shall be 1 person;
- (4) Directors shall be 4 persons and less from each region of Asia, Africa, Latin America, and Europe;
- (5) Director shall be 1 person from the Korean Association of Social Scientists;
- (6) Director shall be 1 person from the General Association of Korean Residents in Japan (Chongryon)

Item 3 The Board of Directors' Meeting shall be called by the director general every three years. And an interim meeting may be called when two thirds of the directors and over request to call the meeting.

Item 4 The Board of Directors' Meeting shall discuss and decide all the important activities of the IJI, elect director general, deputy directors-general, and directors, and accredit honorary director general and honorary deputy directors-general.

Item 5 Director general, deputy directors-general and directors shall have a term of three years and they may be re-elected after their term is expired.

Item 6 The Board of Directors shall confer honorary title on those directors who have made special merits in their activities to study and disseminate the Juche idea after their term is over.

Article 7 Directors of the IJI Board shall be elected when they satisfy the following conditions:

- 1) One with social influence;
- 2) One who has been active in a given organization for more than two years;
- 3) One who is recommended by the regional institute.

Item 2 Directors shall be elected at the Board of Directors' Meeting.

Item 3 In principle, the number of directors elected from one country shall not exceed 2 persons.

Item 4 Directors shall keep contact with the IJI to inform it of their activities regularly.

Article 8 The IJI has a regional institute on each continent.

Item 2 The IJI shall keep contact with the regional institutes for the better study and dissemination of the Juche idea in their regions.

Item 3 The IJI shall cooperate with the regional institutes in making them consist of persons with social influence and ability of conduct.

Item 4 The IJI shall collect information about the study and dissemination of the Juche idea in all regions in close contact with the regional institutes.

Item 5 The IJI shall assist Juche idea study organizations in different countries so that they can strike their root in their own countries and enjoy support of the broad masses.

Item 6 The IJI shall collect information about the study and dissemination of the Juche idea in different countries in close contact with Juche idea study organizations in those countries.

Article 9 The executive body of the IJI shall be the Secretariat.

Item 2 The Secretariat shall conduct its daily activities in conformity with this Statute and decision of the IJI Board.

Item 3 The Secretariat shall consist of secretary general and several members.

Item 4 The secretary general of the IJI shall be appointed by the director general of the IJI and members of the Secretariat shall be appointed by the secretary general.

Article 10 The IJI shall be funded by donations from organizations and individuals in different countries over the world that support the Juche idea and by the income of the IJI.

Article 11 The IJI shall be in Tokyo, Japan.

Article 12 This Statute may be revised at the Board of Directors' Meeting.

Supplementary Provision This Statute shall come into force from April 13, 2014.
