

To Celebrate 60th Anniversary of DPRK& Viotoxy in Korean War, Delegates from International and Regional Unstitutes of Unote Idea Visit DPRK, Gatherings Held in Various Parts of World

July 27 this year falls on the 60th anniversary of signing the Korean War Armistice Agreement. The DPRK's victory in the Korean War became the start of going downhill of U.S. imperialism that had boasted of being the strongest in the world at that time. It was a historic fact that left a major mark on the world's history.

To celebrate the anniversary with the Korean people, delegates from the International Institute of the Juche Idea (IIJI) and respective regional institutes of the Juche idea, delegations from national governments, and those of Korean friendship and solidarity organizations from different countries visited the DPRK.

Similarly, seminars and meetings to mark it were held throughout the world.

Celebrations Held in Pyongyang in Presence of First Secretary Kim Jong Un

To celebrate the 60th anniversary of the DPRK's Victory in the Korean War, Dr. Vishwanath, director general of the IIJI Board; Dr. Ogami Kenichi, secretary general of the IIJI; Prof. Harish Gupta, director general of the Board of Directors of the Asian Regional Institute of the Juche Idea (ARIJI); Mr. Henry Masiko, director general of the Board of Directors of the African Regional Committee for the Study of the Juche Idea (ARCSJI), Prof. Matteo Carbonelli, secretary general of the Juche Idea (ERSSJI) visited Pyongyang to join celebrations.

Among those present were delegations of national governments including the one headed by the Chinese Vice-President and those of friendship bodies.

On July 25, the delegates from the IIJI and the regional institutes were received by President Kim Ki Nam of the Korean Association of Social Scientists (KASS),

who is also secretary of the Central Committee of the Workers' Party of Korea.

While welcoming them, the President addressed as follows: it was a miracle that a country, which was after only two years of its decolonization, defeated the "world's mightiest" US imperialists and their allies. The victory achieved by the Korean people was a triumph of strength of mind and thought and of the people armed with ideology.

During their stay, the delegates visited the Kumsusan Palace of the Sun to pay homage to President Kim II Sung and General Secretary Kim Jong II, and attended various events marking the anniversary conducted in presence of First Secretary Kim Jong Un including a military parade and mass demonstration.

Commemorative Meetings Organized around World

Seminars and meetings observing the anniversary were held in many places of the world including India, Bangladesh, Benin, Romania, Austria, Peru and Venezuela.

At a national seminar organized in New Delhi on July 20, 2013, Dr. Vishwanath mentioned as follows:

"I would like to offer felicitations to H.E. Kim Jong Un, and the Govt of DPR Korea for their efforts to avoid war and for the great successes, they achieved in 1953, turning DPR Korea into a paradise and as an Independent and Sovereign state."

Seminar on Independence of Africa

A regional seminar on independence of Africa was held in Kampala, the capital of Uganda, on May 11, 2013. It was attended by some 100 people including Ugandan government officials, university professors, youth and students, Juche idea researchers from countries across Africa.



The seminar was presided over by Director General Henry Masiko of the ARCSJI Board, who is commissioner for Patriotism Clubs in the Office of the President of Uganda.

Mr. Kirunda Kivejinja, senior advisor to the President's Office of Uganda, delivered a keynote address, which was followed by a congratulatory address of Vice-President Ri Kil Song of the KASS on behalf of guests of honor.

At the seminar, representatives from Juche idea study groups in Tanzania, Egypt, Nigeria, DR of the Congo, South Africa, Ethiopia, Tunisia, Benin and Uganda gave their speeches.

They stressed that all the African peoples should unite to wage their terminal struggles for reattaining the independence of Africa and its dignity, by drawing lessons from their sufferings inflicted during colonial rules, and what is needed for the African countries is ideological education which provides the path for the people to follow and defends their dignity.

The seminar adopted an appeal showing support for and solidarity with the Korean people advancing the path of independence and socialism while breaking through the aggressive maneuvers by imperialists.
